- > **CONTACT US** : Direct users to the contact channel page.




## 2. BROWSING INFORMATION

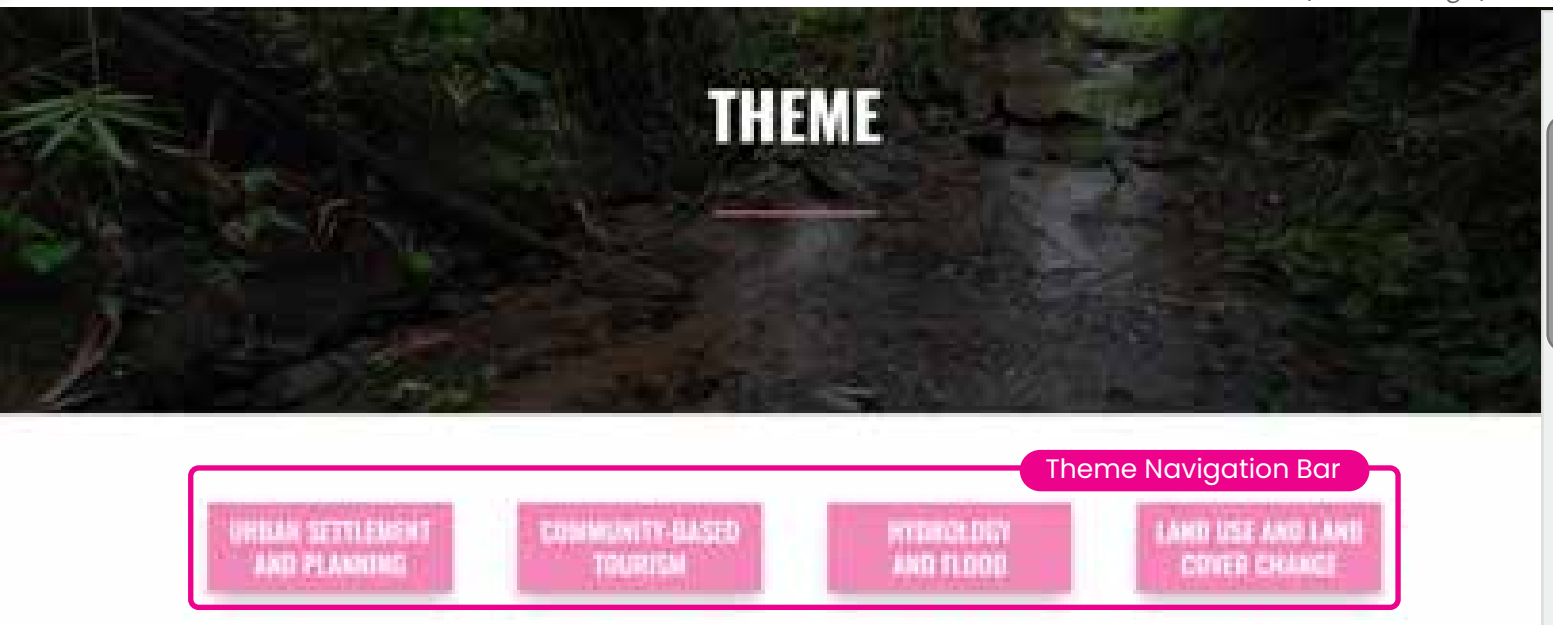

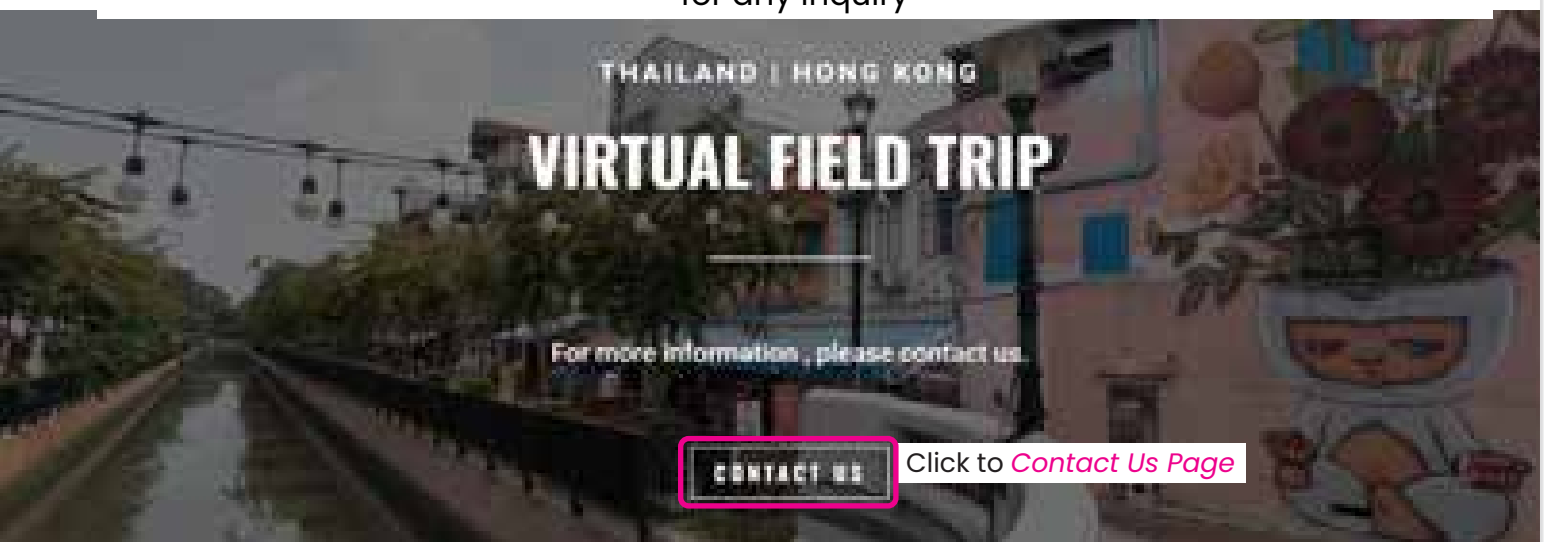

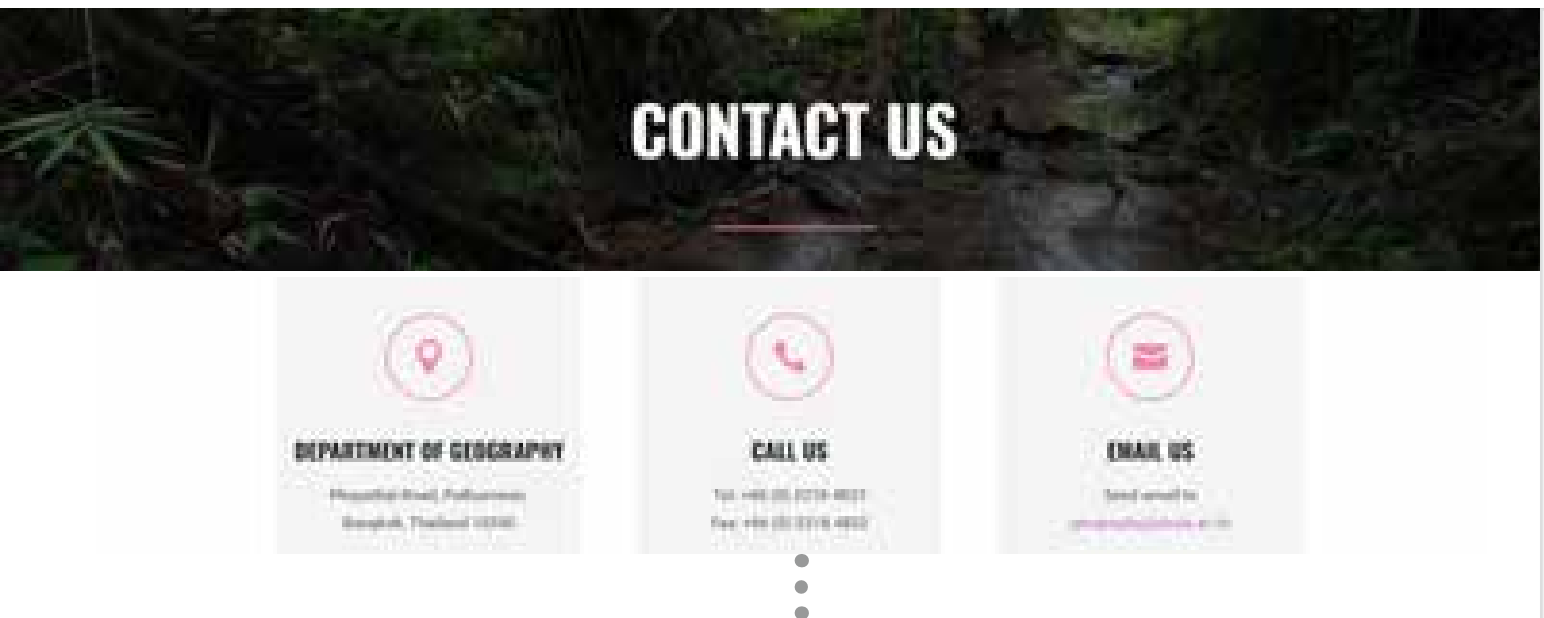

#### Urban Settlement and Planning

Three sub areas defined by the settlement forms and characteristics:

- Klong/Klong Ong Ang:** New reclamation project and canal restoration, community participation activities with extended MRT accessibility. Recently, it won a 2020 Asian Townscape Awards from UN Habitat Regional Office for Asia and the Pacific. It is located in the southern part of Rob Klong canal.
- Manglamphu:** Multicultural community. Thai, Chinese, Mon, and Muslim cultures. It has mixed types of landuse, various human activities and long history of settlement development from paddle field, royal craftsmanship, various types of markets, tourist destination and nightlife respectively. It is situated in the northernmost part of Rob Klong canal and along Chan Phraya River.

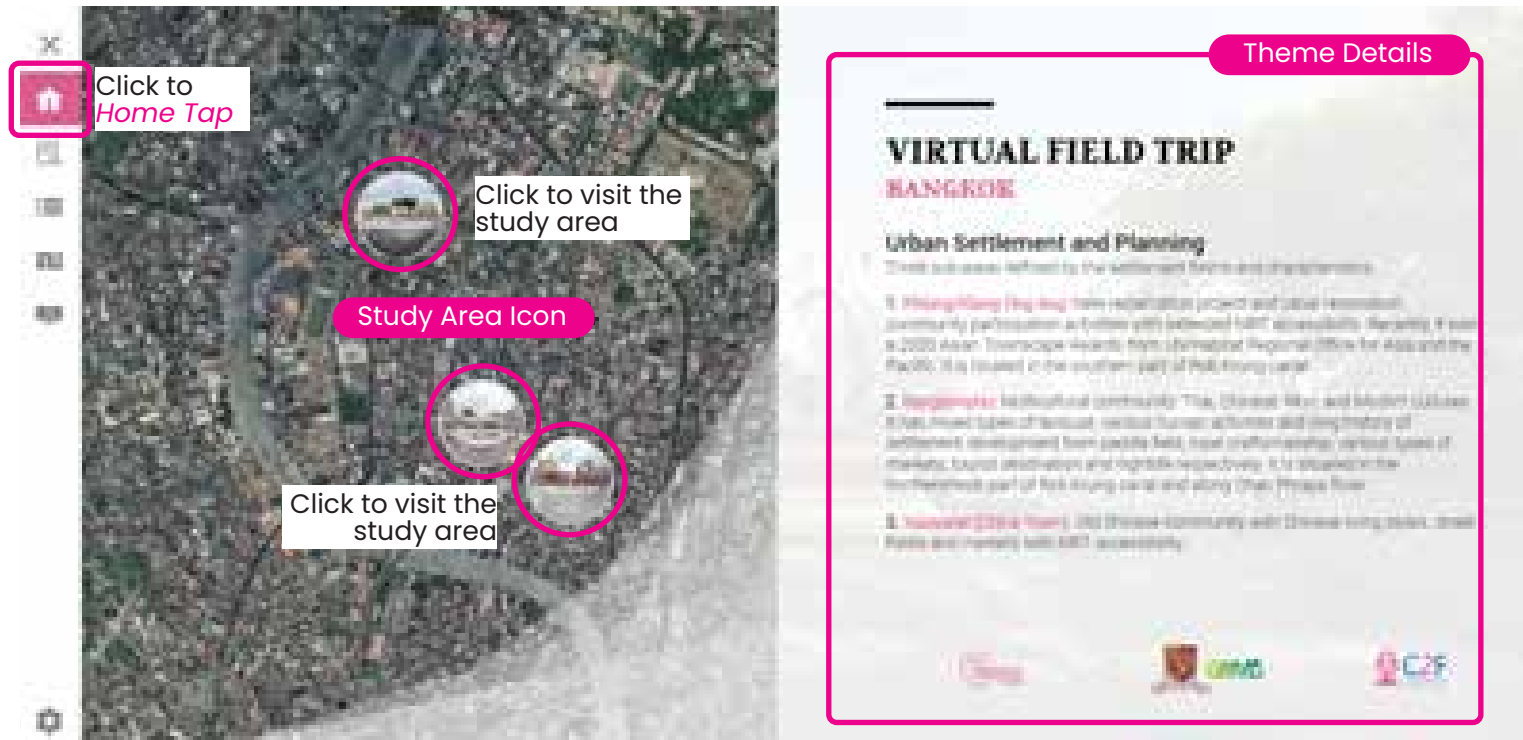

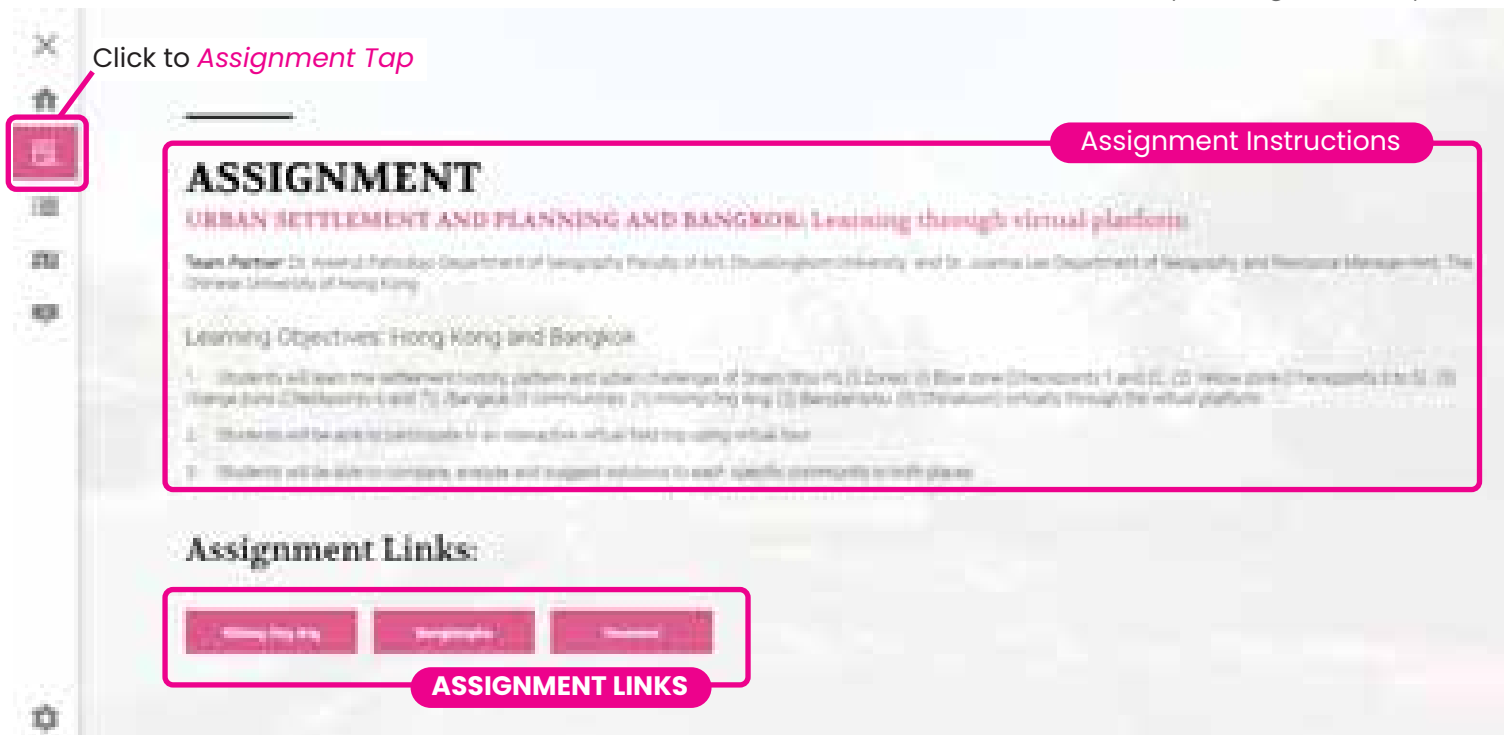



To choose a place to visit, users can click on the circle corresponding to each location displayed on the map. Subsequently, they can read the details of the theme on the right side of the screen.

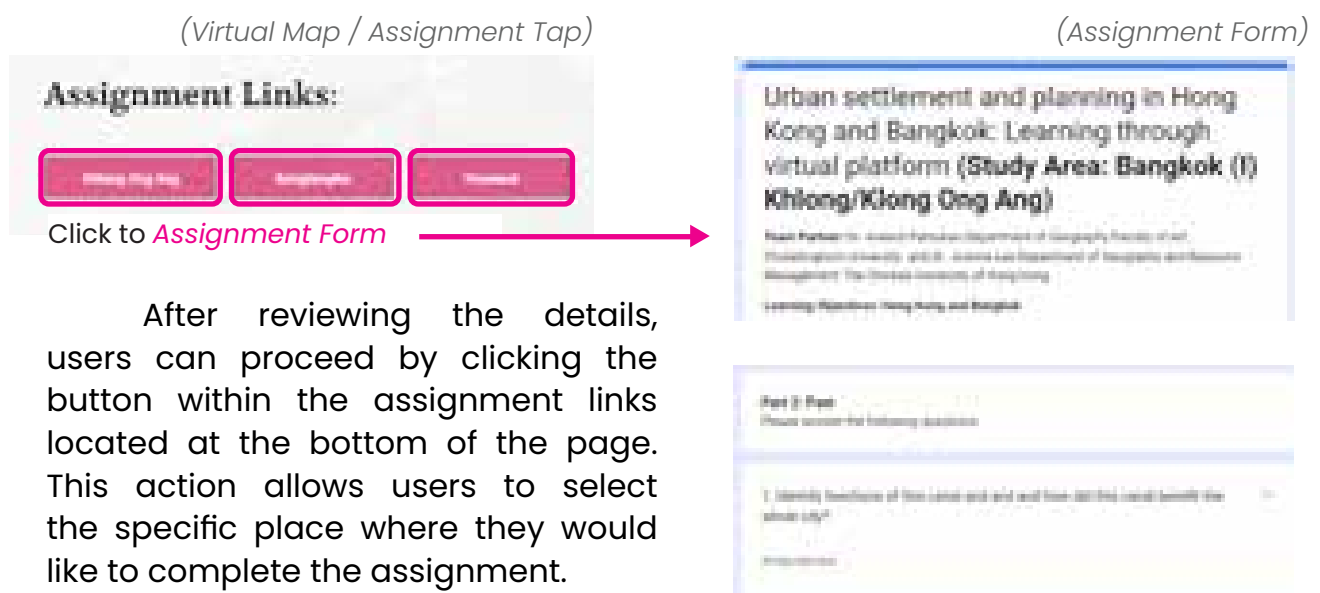

Users can access the panorama view of each checkpoint by clicking on **PANORAMA LIST**  in the left sidebar. Furthermore, they can choose the desired place and checkpoint to visit by clicking on the respective options available in the *panorama dropdown list*.

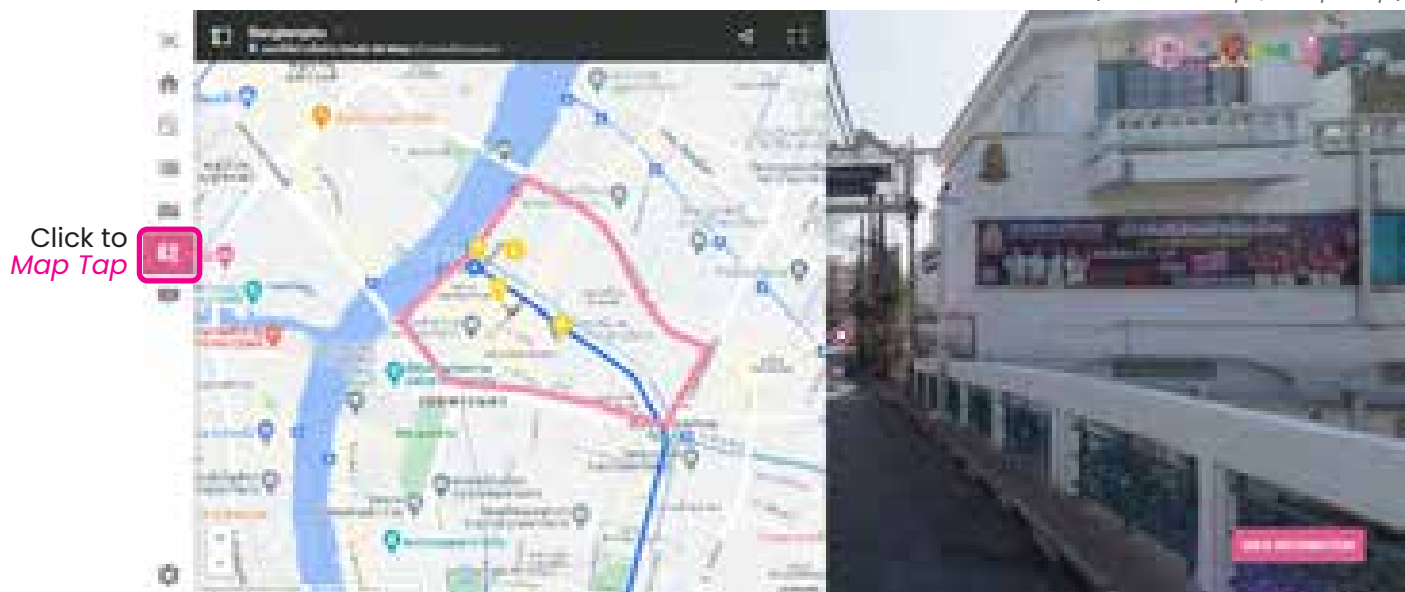

- 1 Users can select the place they wish to visit by clicking on **THE CIRCLE CORRESPONDING** to each location displayed on the map. Following this selection, users can initiate the tour by clicking on **START TOUR** to view the street view of the chosen place.



## 4.1 NAVIGATION

- 1 click on screen and drag the cursor to rotate view

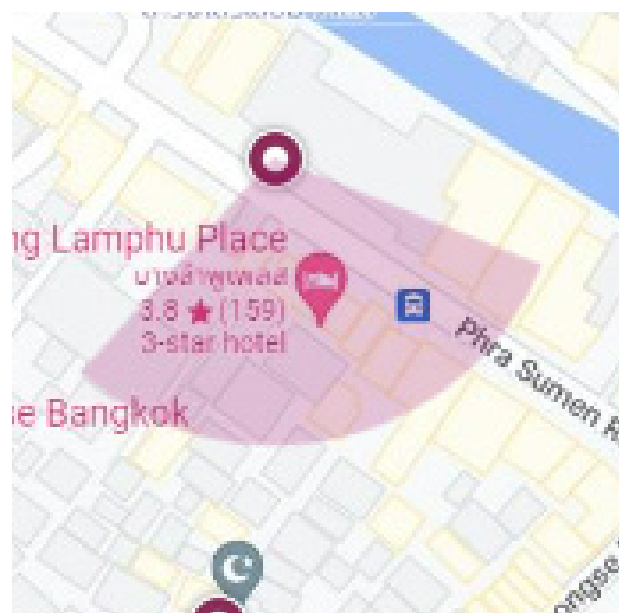


- 2 Click on **THE MAP CHECKPOINT** in *the floor plan* to navigate to the selected area.




- 1 To rotate the view, click on the virtual tour display area. After clicking, hold down the mouse button, and drag the cursor to rotate the camera view of the virtual tour.
- 2 To navigate to a pinned location on **THE FLOOR PLAN**, user can click on the checkpoint icon corresponding to the desired place. This action will guide them to the specified location.

- In *the floor plan*, the pink “fan” shape denotes the camera’s view zone “and direction” in the virtual tour.





- 3** To navigate to *the next checkpoint*, users can click on either **THE POINT**  or **THE CIRCLE OF THE PICTURE** on the map.

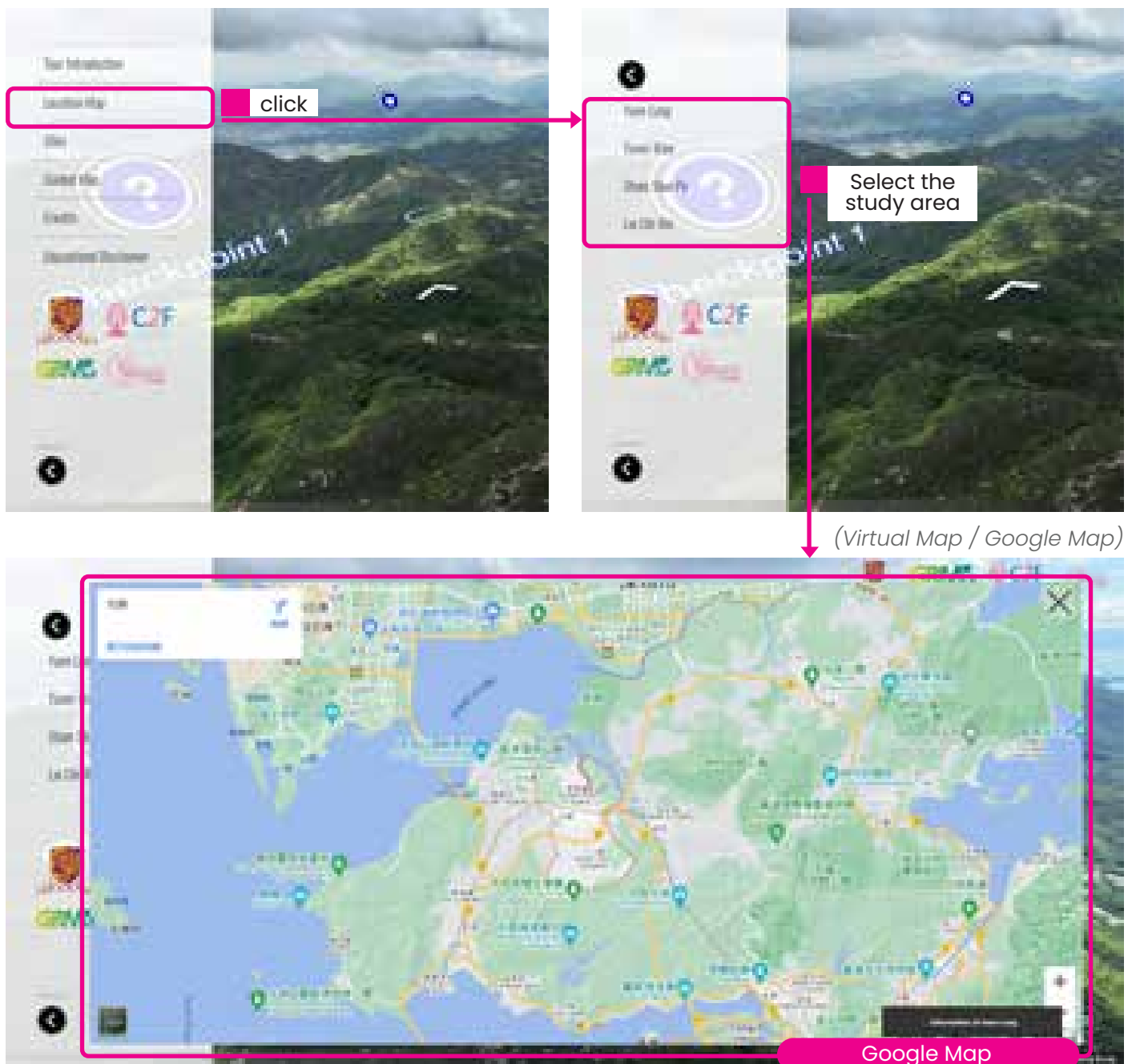

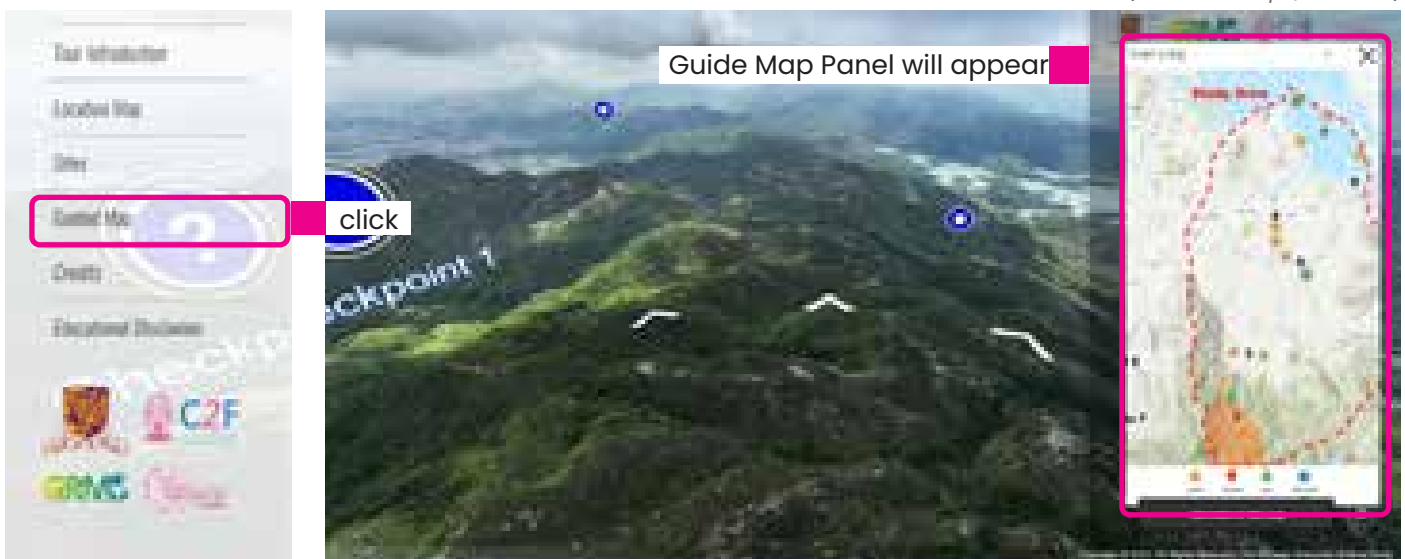

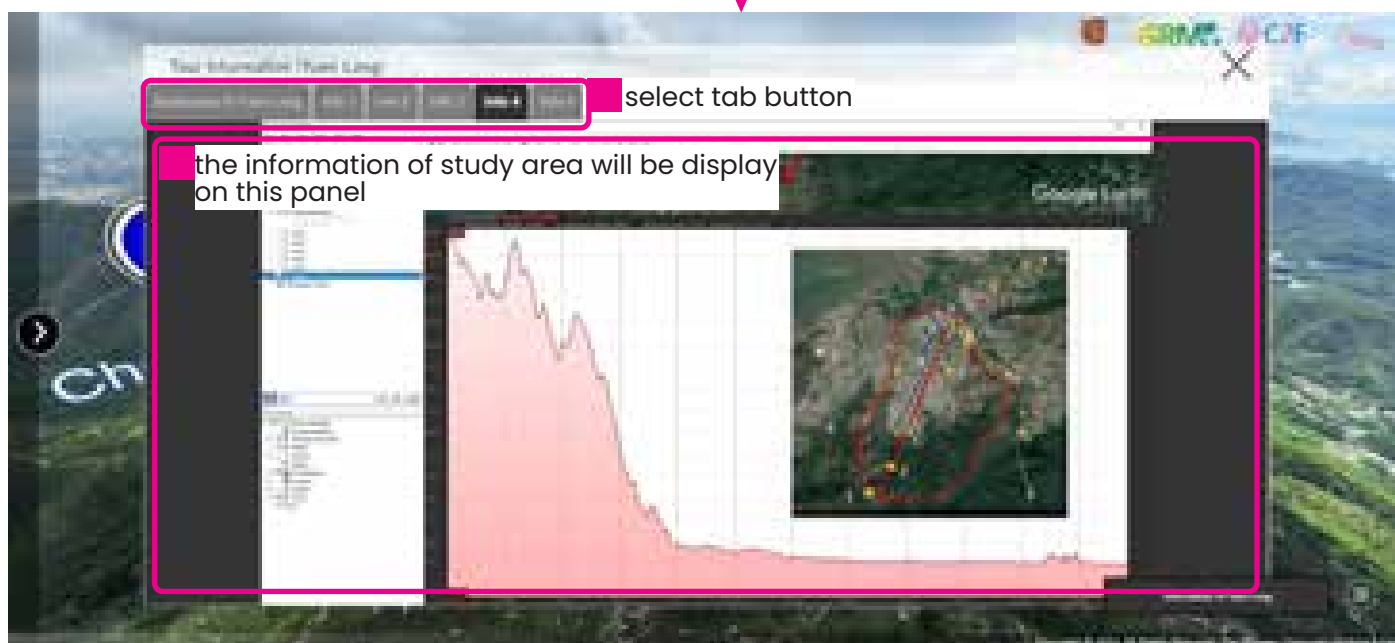
## 5.2 INFORMATION BUTTON

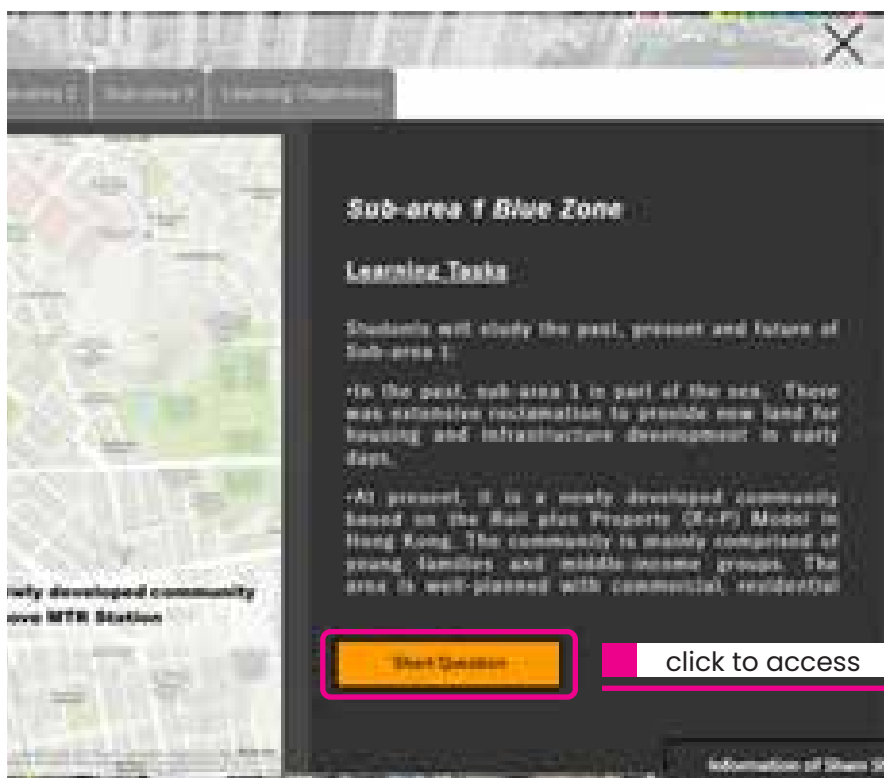

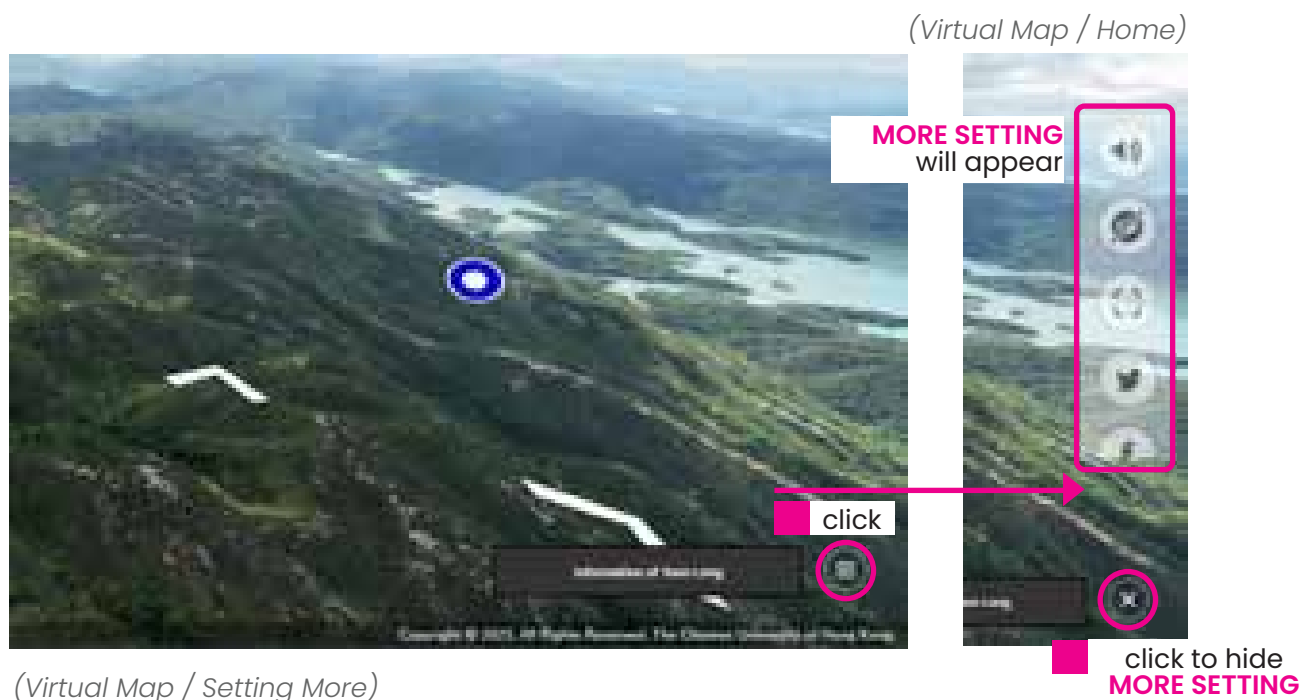

## 6. CONTENTS IN HONG KONG VIRTUAL TOUR

### 6.1 NAVIGATION

(Virtual Map)



**1** To rotate the view of the virtual tour, users can click on the virtual tour display area. After clicking, hold down the mouse button, and drag the cursor to rotate the camera view of the virtual tour.

**2** To adjust the view of the virtual tour, users can follow these steps: click on the virtual tour display area, hold down the mouse button, and then drag the cursor to rotate the camera view as desired.

**3** To navigate to a pinned location on the guided map panel, the user can click on the checkpoint icon corresponding to the desired place. This action will guide them to the specified location.

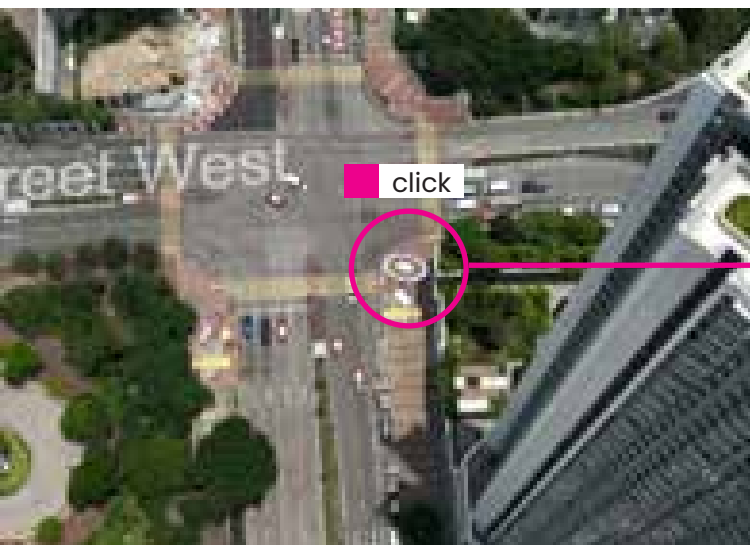


In *the guided map*, the orange shape denotes the camera's view zone in the virtual tour.

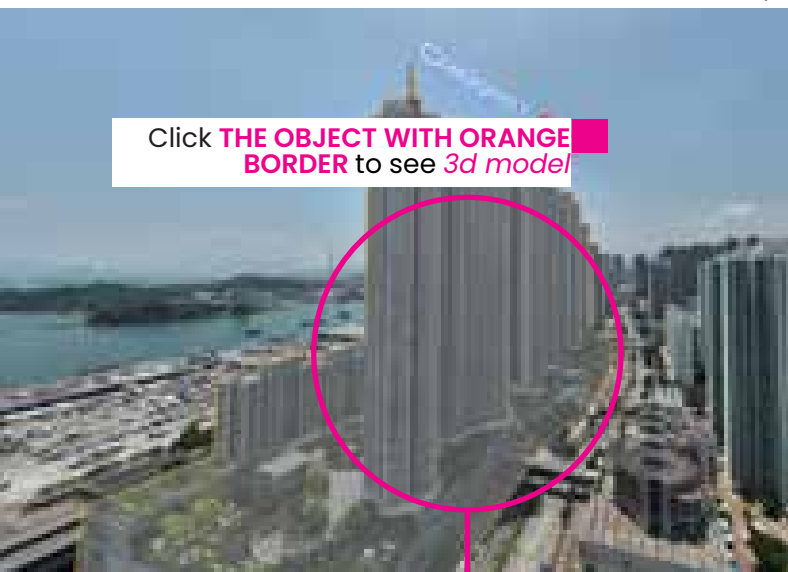

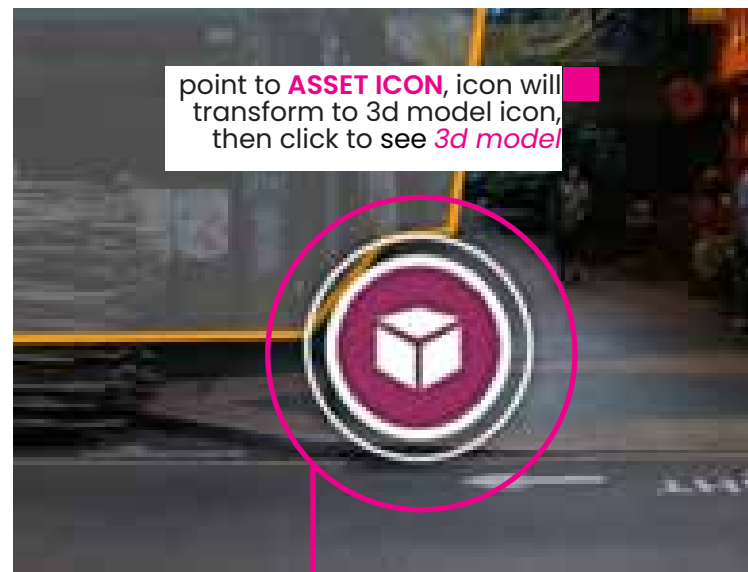

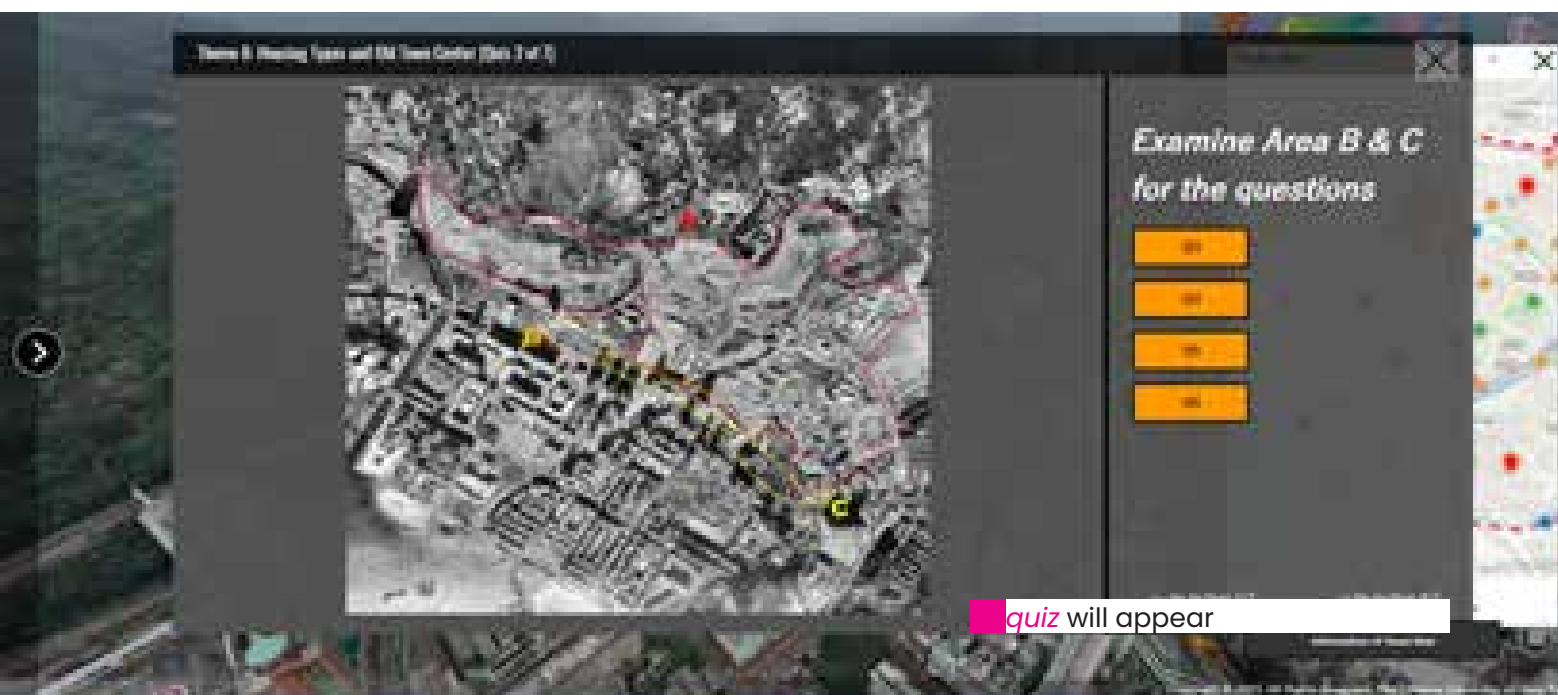
